Copies of any correspondence which may have resulted from our review of the application are also included, as is a copy of the grant of type acceptance (FCC Form 723-A or 731). The data base referred to is a published listing, by manufacturer and type number, of transmitters which have been granted type acceptance. The listing is a summary of essential technical information about the equipment, including Commission rules under which the equipment is eligible for licensing, rated frequency range, rated power, notes containing any specific restrictions or limitations on acceptability of the equipment. The data base is presently maintained by the Office of Managing Director of the Commission, although its maintenance is being transferred to the Commission's Office of Science and Technology.  a.
