Background Information

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) was enacted for the following purposes: to preserve and create jobs and promote economic recovery; to assist those most impacted by the recession; to provide investments needed to increase economic efficiency by spurring technological advances in science and health; to invest in transportation, environmental protection, and other infrastructure that would provide long-term economic benefits; and to stabilize State and local government budgets, in order to minimize and avoid reductions in essential services and counterproductive state and local tax increases. The President and the heads of Federal departments and agencies managed and expended the funds made available in this Act so as to achieve its purposes, including commencing expenditures and activities as quickly as possible consistent with prudent management.

FederalReporting.gov was the central government-wide data collection system for federal agencies and recipients of federal awards under Section 1512 (Reports on Use of Funds) of the Recovery Act. Recipients accessed FederalReporting.gov in order to fulfill their reporting obligations. Under the Recovery Act, prime recipients and their delegated sub-recipients were required to submit data on a quarterly basis for grants, loans, and federal contracts.
