	The Commission on Education of the Deaf was established by the Education of the Deaf Act of 1986 (P.L. 99-371) to study infant, early childhood, elementary, secondary, postsecondary, adult and continuing education programs for persons who are deaf. It must also study federally assisted programs relating to instructional media and captioning services. It must submit to Congress and to the President, not later than February 4, 1988, a final report of its study together with recommendations, including specific proposals for legislation, as the Commission deems advisable.
