The National Commission To Ensure a Strong Competitive Airline Industry was a 15-voting member and 11 non-voting member panel established by Section 204 of the Airport and Airway Safety, Capacity, Noise Improvement and Intermodal Transportation Act of 1992 (49 U.S.C. App. 1371 note), as amended by Public Law 103-13 (April 7, 1993). Composed of 10 members from Congress and 15 members from the private industry sector, and one member from the White House staff, its purpose was to investigate the problems of the aviation industry, define their causes, and provide the President and Congress with recommendations on actions that industry and/or government can take to ensure the industry's economic health and competitiveness. The Commission held several public hearings/meetings in Washington, DC to discuss various industry-related topics, and invited written submissions from private citizens and organizations. It submitted a final report to the President on August 19, 1993. The Commission was terminated on September 17, 1993.
