1	<p>The Wiretap Commission File was used by the National Commission for the Review of Federal and State Laws Relating to Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance to assist in the study and evaluation of the effectiveness of Title III of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968. This section governs the use of electronic surveillance in the United States except in cases of national security. The file contains data collected by the Commission in a survey of prosecuting attorneys on the results of wiretaps during the years 1968-1973. Data elements include; agency involved; crimes listed in the application for wiretap; number of persons arrested, indicted, convicted, acquitted, and dismissed by offense or why none; sentences imposed; indictments pending; and other resulting wiretaps.</p> <p>Disposition: Destroy files upon termination of the Commission.</p>
