Between 1973 and 1989, the Center received 21 updates to the ROS. The Directorate of Economic and Policy Analysis has terminated support for the ROS, therefore the Center can expect no further accretions to this series.</p> <p>From frequency distributions run on a sample of the datafiles in the Center's collection, we determined that only the most recent version of the ROS should be permanently retained by the National Archives. The most recent version covers the period January 1970 through December 1988 and appears to contain all records appearing in previous versions of the ROS.</p> <p>Disposition: Destroy immediately all version of the ROS except the most recent.</p>	<p>NN373-207</p>
