The general objective of the statutes administered by the Securities and Exchange Commission is to provide the fullest possible disclosure to the investing public, and protect the interests of the public and investors against malpractice in the securities and financial markets.</p> <p>The Commission, on March 2, 1977, adopted a Records Control Schedule [17 CFR 200.80f), and at the same time authorized the disposal of certain files no longer needed in the ordinary course of business. Card records pertaining to registration statements filed under the Securities Act of 1933 were erroneously classified under Item 1, NCI-266-77-2, and can be disposed of immediately.
