The general objective of the statutes administered by the Securities and Exchange Commission is to provide the fullest possible disclosure to the investing public, and protect the interests of the public and investors against malpractice in the securities and financial markets.</p> <p>After an on-site inspection on August 30, 1982 by the SEC's Records Officer, and in consultation with the Commission's Seattle Regional Office, it was determined that certain modifications could be made in the present retention periods.
