1. Social Indicators of Equality for Minorities and Women  
This one-time study contains data extracted from the public use samples of the 1960 and 1970 censuses and the 1976 Survey of Income and Education. The data was used to develop social indicators which measure, describe, and assess the level of well-being of the minority and female' population to that of the majority male population thereby providing a measure of the nation's progress toward equality. The indicators measure aspects of education, occupation, employment, income, poverty, and housing.

DISPOSITION: Disposable. Transfer to the Center for Machine-Readable Records, Machine-Readable Archives Division, the National Archives and Records Service. Review every five years. Destroy when reference activity ceases.
