


Description: The Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission is an independent federal agency that provides administrative trial and appellate review for contests of citations or penalties resulting from OSHA inspections of American workplaces. Specifically, the Commission handles disputes between the Department of Labor and employers and plays a vital role in encouraging safe and healthy workplaces for American workers.
