1. **Accession Number 021-82-0039, Cash Books. 1927-1942. 1 cubic foot.**

This accession consists of cash books and audit reports for the Hotel Central in the Republic of Panama, and a log book of routine court costs for the court of the U.S. Panama Canal Commission or its predecessor agencies. The cash books for the Hotel Central have fields that include cash, assets, list of equipment, voucher number, article purchased, amount, accounts receivable, accounts payable, bar operating costs, and numerous other fields pertaining to hotel operating costs. One of these cash books was found to contain four audit reports from the Westman Bros, CPA, Republic of Panama. These audit reports document business operations of the Hotel Central from 1926 to 1931 and are labeled defense exhibits. This accession also consists of one court log book from the U.S. Panama Canal Commission or its predecessor agencies. This log book records court expenses from July 1932 to 1942. Examples of fields in this log include cash bail, filing fees, fines, defendant costs, plaintiff docket fees, copies of proceedings, and refund of bail. The cash books and court logs contain the names of individuals.
