Dear Ms. Levesque:

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) received the Department of Energy's (DOE) report of an unauthorized disposition of temporary OGE-450 form records at its headquarters office in Washington, DC. On June 22, 2020, the Office of Counsel discovered that ½ cubic foot of records were damaged due to a water leak caused by a pipe burst in an administrative file room.

Due to the agency's efforts, several records were recovered. However, another 100-150 forms, for which additional copies do not exist, are unrecoverable. To mitigate future risks, DOE plans to store existing paper records in alternative storage areas, away from water pipes; and manage forms created in the future electronically. Based on the information that you provided, the reporting requirements of 36 CFR 1230.14(a) have been met. NARA is satisfied with the safeguards established and considers this matter closed.
