The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) acknowledges receipt of the Department of the Air Force (AF) report on the loss of Civil Engineering Squadron (CES) records.

According to the report, nineteen boxes were lost in transit from the Traffic Management Office (TMO), 48th Logistics Readiness Squadron (LRS), RAF Lakenheath to the Federal Records Center (FRC) in Philadelphia, PA. Numerous tracking requests were made in regard to the shipment but the records were not located. The 48 LRS Installation Transportation Office Superintendent now considers the records lost.
