The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) received an allegation of unauthorized disposition of records from the Department of Defense (DOD), National Security Agency/Central Security Service (NSA/CSS). This allegation indicates that the NSA improperly disposed of agency records responsive to an April 2025 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request which sought information the requester submitted in 2019 using the "Contact Us" feature on the NSA's website.

On July 9, 2025, the NSA reviewed this allegation and communicated with NARA that no unauthorized disposition had occurred. The records schedule that applies to records submitted through NSA's Public Affairs (Contact Us) web portal is GRS 6.4, item 020, Public correspondence and communication not requiring formal action. These records are temporary with a 90-day retention period (DAA-GRS-2016-0005-0002).

NARA acknowledges that since the requester submitted their FOIA request after the 90-day retention period, no responsive records were located because the record in question had already been destroyed in accordance with GRS 6.4, item 020.

Based on this information, the reporting requirements of 36 CFR 1230.14(a) have been met and NARA considers this matter closed. I appreciate your attention to this matter. If you have any
