#### NONPOPULATION CENSUS SCHEDULES FOR MINNESOTA, 1860: AGRICULTURE

#### Introduction

On the single roll of this microfilm publication, M1802, are reproduced the agricultural schedules for Minnesota taken during the enumeration of the 8th Federal Census in 1860. The material reproduced is part of the Records of the Bureau of the Census, Record Group (RG) 29.

## Background

In 1969 this census was in the custody of the Minnesota Historical Society. It was microfilmed for the society on September 19, 1969, by the Dakota Microfilm Service, St. Paul, MN. In due course, one positive copy was deposited in the National Archives Microfilm Reading Room for use by researchers. In 1994 this roll was assigned a number, M1802, in order to issue it as an official National Archives Microfilm Publication.

#### **Records Description**

These records are reproduced in the order filmed. They are arranged by county, thereunder by township or town. The counties are arranged alphabetically, with one exception: Murray is between "Cottenwood" and Crow Wing. Within counties, the pagination generally begins at page 1; however, the pages were not always filmed in strict numerical order. Arrangement of towns and townships also varies. For some counties, the township/town arrangement is alphabetical; for others, it is random. Sometimes the township name is simply given as the township number and range number assigned during surveying (such as T. 101, R. 13), although frequently the township name and/or post office name was also recorded by the enumerator. If the enumerator did not record the township name, the table of contents that follows this introduction indicates the post office (P.O.) name.

In 1860 "Schedule 4--PRODUCTIONS OF AGRICULTURE" required the assistant marshal to obtain certain information about "all farms or plantations, the produce of which amounts to \$100 [or more] in value," but the schedule was "not intended to include the returns of small lots, owned or worked by persons following mechanical or other pursuits, where the productions are not \$100 [or more] in value." Information was requested for 48 categories, including the name of the owner, agent, or manager of the farm; the number of acres; cash value of the farm, farming implements, and machinery; number of each kind of livestock; amount of various kinds of crops and other farm products produced during the year ended June 1, 1860; and value of any homemade manufactures and animals slaughtered.
