NONPOPULATION CENSUS SCHEDULES FOR UTAH TERRITORY
AND VERMONT, 1870: MORTALITY

Introduction

On the single roll of this microfilm publication, M1807, are reproduced the mortality schedules for Utah and Vermont enumerated during the Ninth Census of the United States in 1870. These records were in the possession of, and were microfilmed by, the Texas State Library in January 1950. Two copies were deposited in the National Archives, including one that was placed in the Microfilm Reading Room for use by researchers. In 1994 this microfilm was assigned number M1807 in order to issue it as an official National Archives Microfilm Publication.

These records are reproduced in the order filmed by the Texas State Library. They are arranged by state, thereunder by county, and thereunder by town or other subdivision. Within each county, some towns or subdivisions are listed alphabetically while others are randomly arranged.

The second half of the Vermont schedules appears to have been poorly filmed. Material from the town of Rutland, Rutland County, Vermont, includes copies of pages from the town's death records.
