

French Convoy Check

East Berlin ADN Domestic Service in German 1836 GMT 5 November 1963--L

(Text) Berlin--A French military convoy of eight trucks and two jeeps, with 47 persons, turned up at the GDR autobahn checkpoint at Drewitz on the state frontier with West Berlin this evening. The French soldiers at first refused to dismount for checking. After nearly one hour they allowed themselves to be checked and then continued their journey unhindered.
