

GDR STOPS FRG DRIVER WITH DELIVERY FOR U.S. BERLIN EMBASSY

[Text] Berlin--At the GDR checkpoint Heinrich-Heine-Strasse, a 37-year-old motorist from the Federal Republic was denied entry to East Berlin today. The GDR border guards gave no reason for it. According to West Berlin police, the man was traveling with a truck which was to deliver furniture to the U.S. Embassy in East Berlin. After the 37-year-old man had been refused entry, three other employees of the moving firm were allowed to continue the delivery without obstruction.
