

ADN REPORT CITED ON 22 FEBRUARY BORDER INCIDENT

East Berlin Voice of the GDR Domestic Service in German 1700 GMT 24 Feb 75 LD

[Text] ADN, today, has reported the details of the border provocation of 22 February in the area of Klein-Glienicke. According to the report, West Berlin provocateurs laid two concealed ignition charges on GDR territory. In touching them, a member of the GDR border security force sustained serious head wounds and had to be taken to the hospital. The sight of the seriously injured man's left eye is in jeopardy.

The criminal assault, ADN says, is one of a series of provocations which have been repeatedly launched of late from West Berlin against the GDR, and which have led to the acute imperilling of human lives. These assaults are favored by the fact that the West Berlin Senat, despite repeated exhortations on the part of the GDR Government, fails to take measures to stop these acts directed against detente and to call their originators to account.
