**MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE**

**Subject: Berlin Intelligence Activities (U)**

1. By SM-938-59, dated 22 September 1959, you were informed of the instructions issued by the Joint Chiefs of Staff to USCINCEUR to take the necessary measures to effect coordination of U.S. military intelligence activities with those of the CIA in West Germany and Berlin. In response to these instructions, USCINCEUR has forwarded his plans and those of the U.S. Commander, Berlin (USCOB), for review by the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

2. It has been noted that these plans have been subject to full coordination between your designated representatives in West Germany and Berlin and the appropriate military commander, in each case.

3. Copies of Draft Appendix 2 to Annex "D", USCINCEUR OPLAN NR. 100-1; EUCOM Directive 40-7; and the USCOB Plan for the Coordination of Intelligence Activities in Berlin; and the memorandum by the Joint Chiefs of Staff for USCINCEUR, are forwarded herewith for your information.
