I hereby certify that upon application by GEORGE GORDON LIDDY for discharge from imprisonment pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 3569, the said GEORGE GORDON LIDDY appeared before me on September 6, 1977 at 2:00 p.m. and offered evidence in support of his application.

I further certify that it appears to me that GEORGE GORDON LIDDY is unable to pay the required amount of fine of \$40,000.00 and has no property exceeding \$20.00 in value except such as is by law exempt from execution by debt; and that he has taken the prescribed oath to that effect.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT GEORGE GORDON LIDDY be discharged from further imprisonment on the 7th day of September, 1977, which is the date when he will have completed the confinement portion of his sentence.

As you probably know, G. Gordon Liddy appeared before a Magistrate in our district a few days ago to sign the necessary oath of poverty so that he could be paroled from custody and not remain incarcerated on the basis of the fine owed. As part of the above procedure, Mr. Liddy turned over his National Service Life Insurance Policy as security for the fine and along with it, gave us an assignment of that policy to you as Clerk of the District Court for the District of Columbia.

Based on the above, I am sending you with this letter for recording in your district and for any other action necessary on your part, the following items:


- 1) A certified copy of the oath of the prisoner.

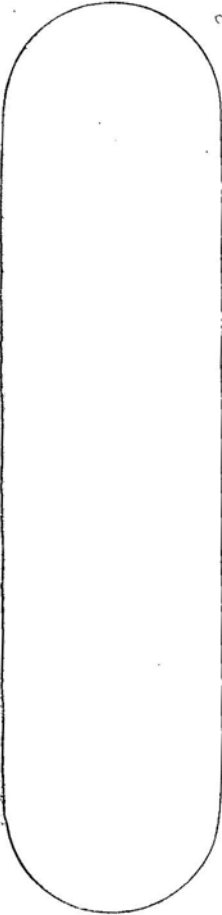
