APPRAISAL OF COMMENT: ADZHUBEY PROBABLY MADE THE COMMENTS AS REPORTED.

DURING A RECEPTION AT THE SOVIET EMBASSY, ALEKSEY ADZHUBEY CRITICIZED HIS GOVERNMENT'S ERROR IN OVEREMPHASIZING INDUSTRY AT THE EXPENSE OF AGRICULTURE. HE URGED THE SOVIET DIPLOMATIC COMMUNITY TO INCREASE HIS CONTACT WITH THE THAI PEOPLE IN ORDER TO IMPROVE REPORTING ON LOCAL CONDITIONS. ADZHUBEY FELT THE THAIS SHOULD KNOW THE SOVIETS BETTER TOO. ADZHUBEY SAID SEATO, CENTO AND NATO ARE USELESS, THAT THERE IS TROUBLE IN VIETNAM AS WELL AS LAOS, AND THAT THAILAND SHOULD LEAVE THE CHINA PROBLEM TO THE USSR. LATER COMMENTS BY ADZHUBEY TO PRIME MINISTER THANOM AND DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER THANAT ON POOR PRESS COVERAGE OF SOVIET EVENTS AND RECEPTIONS CS-3/567,770.

AT A RECEPTION GIVEN IN HIS HONOR AT THE SOVIET EMBASSY, BANGKOK, 24 NOVEMBER 1963, ALEKSEY ADZHUBEY, IZVESTIYA EDITOR AND KHRUSHCHEV'S SON-IN-LAW, DELIVERED A SPEECH TO SOVIET BLOC REPRESENTATIVES WHO HAD BEEN INVITED TO STAY AFTER THE RECEPTION. ADZHUBEY EXPRESSED DEEP PERSONAL AND NATIONAL REGRET AT THE DEATH OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND EULOGIZED HIS SERVICE TO EASE WORLD TENSION. CONCERNING THE SOVIET UNION, ADZHUBEY EXPRESSED THE BELIEF THE GOVERNMENT HAD ERRED IN PLACING TOO GREAT AN EMPHASIS ON INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT WITH TOO LITTLE THOUGHT OR EFFORT FOR THE AGRICULTURAL NEEDS OF THE POPULATION. THIS LED TO THE SHORTAGE OF WHEAT IN RUSSIA AND IN OTHER COUNTRIES IN GENERAL. ADZHUBEY EMPHASIZED THAT MEMBERS OF THE SOVIET DIPLOMATIC COMMUNITY IN THAILAND SHOULD MAKE GREATER EFFORTS TO COME IN CONTACT WITH THE THAI PEOPLE TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THAILAND AND ITS PEOPLE. THIS CONCERNING THE MATTER, HE STATED, THAT SOME CONTACTS MAY NOT AGREE WITH THE SOVIET POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY - THERE ARE MANY OTHER AREAS ON WHICH RATHER DIFFERENT OPINIONS. THE SOVIETS SHOULD LEARN MORE ABOUT THAILAND, BUT IT IS MORE IMPORTANT FOR THE THAI TO KNOW THE SOVIETS BETTER.

ACCORDING TO AN OFFICIAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS WHO WAS ASSIGNED TO MONITOR ADZHUBEY'S ACTIVITIES DURING HIS VISIT TO BANGKOK FROM 24 NOVEMBER THROUGH 3 DECEMBER 1963, ADZHUBEY HELD SEVERAL CONFERENCES AND HAD PRIVATE DISCUSSIONS WITH VARIOUS THAI GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS. DURING THESE DISCUSSIONS, ADZHUBEY MADE THE FOLLOWING COMMENTS-

- A. SEATO, NATO, AND CENTO ARE USELESS. THESE ORGANIZATIONS DO NOT PREVENT WORLD TENSION, AND IF A NUCLEAR WAR SHOULD BREAK OUT, ONE BOMB WOULD DESTROY EVERYTHING.
- B. FASCISTS IN THE UNITED STATES WERE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEATH OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. ADZHUBEY REFERRED TO HIS PREVIOUS DISCUSSIONS WITH AN AMERICAN AUTHOR, JOHN STEINBECK, WHO REPORTEDLY SAID THAT FASCISTS WERE STIRRING UP THE INTERNAL POLITICAL SITUATION IN THE UNITED STATES.
- C. IN ANSWER TO A QUESTION POSED TO HIM REGARDING STRONGER SOVIET ACTION ON THE LAO PROBLEM, ADZHUBEY POINTED OUT THAT THERE IS ALSO TROUBLE IN BERLIN.
- D. WHEN ASKED IF THE USSR CAN HELP, SINCE THAILAND IS VERY CONCERNED ABOUT CHINESE COMMUNIST INTERVENTION IN SOUTHEAST ASIA, ADZHUBEY ANSWERED, "LEAVE CHINA TO THE USSR."

SUMMARY: DURING A RECEPTION AT THE SOVIET EMBASSY, ALEXSEY ADZHUBEY EXPRESSED HIS GOVERNMENT'S ERROR IN OVERPHASIZING INDUSTRY AT THE EXPENSE OF AGRICULTURE. HE URGED THE SOVIET DIPLOMATIC COMMITTEE TO INCREASE ITS CONTACT WITH THE THAI PEOPLE IN ORDER TO IMPROVE REPORTING ON LOCAL CONDITIONS. ADZHUBEY FELT THE THAIS SHOULD KNOW THE SOVIETS BETTER FOR THE SAKE OF NATO, CENTO AND NATO AND USNESS, THAT THERE IS CONTACT IN THAILAND AS WELL AS LAOS, AND THAT THAILAND SHOULD LEARN THE GREAT LESSONS FROM THE USSR. LATER COMMENTS BY ADZHUBEY TO PRIME MINISTER THANAT AND TO THE PRIME MINISTER THANAT ON POOR PRESS COVERAGE OF SOVIET EVENTS ARE REFERRED TO IN CS-1509,710.

AT A RECEPTION GIVEN IN HIS HONOR AT THE SOVIET EMBASSY, BANGKOK, ON 30 NOVEMBER 1963, ALEXSEY ADZHUBEY, EMERSON EDITOR AND KIROUSHNEV'S SON-IN-LAW, DELIVERED A SPEECH TO SOVIET BLOC REPRESENTATIVES WHO HAD BEEN ASKED TO STAY AFTER THE RECEPTION. ADZHUBEY EXPRESSED DEEP PERSONAL AND NATIONAL REGRET AT THE DEATH OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND PRAISED HIS EFFORTS TO LESSEN WORLD TENSION. CONCERNING THE SOVIET UNION, ADZHUBEY EXPLAINED THAT THE GOVERNMENT HAD ERRED IN PLACING TOO GREAT AN EMPHASIS ON INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT WITH TOO LITTLE THOUGHT OR EFFORT FOR THE AGRICULTURAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE POPULATION. THIS LED TO THE SHORTAGE OF WHEAT IN PARTICULAR AND RICE IN GENERAL. ADZHUBEY EMPHASIZED THAT MEMBERS OF THE SOVIET DIPLOMATIC COMMITTEE IN THAILAND SHOULD MAKE GREATER EFFORTS TO CONTACT THE LOCAL POPULATION TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THAILAND AND ITS PEOPLE. THIS WOULD RESULT IN BETTER AND MORE COMPREHENSIVE REPORTING ON LOCAL CONDITIONS. IT DOES NOT MEAN, HE STATED, THAT SOME CONTACTS MAY NOT AGREE WITH THE SOVIET NATIONAL PHILOSOPHY - THERE ARE MANY OTHER AREAS ON WHICH RAPPORT CAN BE BASED. THE SOVIETS SHOULD LEARN MORE ABOUT THAILAND, BUT IT IS EQUALLY IMPORTANT FOR THE THAIS TO KNOW THE SOVIETS BETTER.

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ACCORDING TO AN OFFICIAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS WHO WAS ASSIGNED TO MONITOR ADZHUBEY'S ACTIVITIES TO OUR OFFICE FROM 24 NOVEMBER THROUGH 3 DECEMBER 1963, ADZHUBEY ATTENDED SEVERAL CONFERENCES AND HAD PRIVATE DISCUSSIONS WITH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS. DURING THESE DISCUSSIONS, ADZHUBEY MADE THE FOLLOWING COMMENTS-

- 1. SEATO, NATO, AND CENTO ARE USELESS. THESE ORGANIZATIONS DO NOT SAVE THE WORLD FROM WAR AND IF A NUCLEAR WAR SHOULD BREAK OUT, ONE OF THEM WOULD DESTROY EVERYTHING.
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
