REFERENCE(S)

1. Kosti VASA, Chief of the Central Criminal Police, stated that on 28 May 1959, G. E. GOLUB, Soviet Consul in Helsinki had asked him for information on Subject, born 28 March 1926 in Ingermanland. Subject entered Sweden in 1947, and was the bearer of Svenskt framlingspass No. 7275/47. According to Golub, Subject had disappeared from the Birgitta Hospital in Vadstena, Sweden on 20 May 1959.
2. Vasa stated that Golub seemed to be "in a sweat" to get information on Subject, but did not reveal his reason for wanting it. Vasa conjectured that Subject may be either suspected by the Soviets of being "a NATO dispatched spy," or "a Soviet recruited spy who decided to give up the business". Vasa added that Subject might possibly be in the Soviet Union now, and having been apprehended, the Soviets want to determine whether he was sent by the West, or voluntarily returned to the Motherland.
3. Vasa expects no additional information on Subject from us, but it would be interesting to know whether Headquarters or Stockholm files contain any information on Subject.
4. Vasa stated that G. E. Golub is extremely active in cultivating Finnish police officials at the upper levels, and regularly invites him, VAGUS/1, VASTINA/1, and Helsinki Police Chief Karl Erik Gabrielsson, separately, to lunch. Vasa claimed that Golub had lunch with some Finn "every day".
