5. (N) 35 requested the summaries of the (NICONVINIER T and KOSTENKO information which had been promised them in order to plan the attack and Jouvenoy passed, the information on 8 April. Jouvenoy discussed an interrogation plan with (N) 35 and, although (N) 35 was hesitant to set a date for the interrogation, he gave the impression that the plans were firm. Several days later, (N) 35 told Jouvenoy that it appeared (N) 97 had lost interest in Lydia, and there was therefore no pressure to interrogate X ST-NKO. The relatively strong position which (NIGHTINGALE) had for the interrogation of an RIS agent (they even had jurisdiction!) was appreciated but discarded.

6. Pavel DMHTMUK returned to Belgium in July 1957 to try and get Lydia's vise expedited, so it is not inconceivable that Lydia may find a stronger sponsor than (Ny97, and (Ny2 might be again forced into considering action against KOST.2MO.O. O.
