SPECIFIC U.J. Embassy and Italian Petroleum Industry.

- 1. Following are DENTER's comments (22 July 1955), which he asserts reflect rumors circulating in "knowledgeable circles" in Rome, on the alleged activities of the ambassy in the matter of Italian petroleum resources.
- The great majority of Italian petroleum companies, which until the IV World Coprolaum Congress opposed ENI, are now presenting a united front with Enrico ATTRI in his opposition to the exploitation of Italian petroleum deposits by American interests. This new situation is the result of confidential information and advice furnished to the Italian patroleum groups and to MATTEI himself by Remigio Danilo WILLO. GNILLO, vice-director general of political affairs in the Italian Foreign Ministry, is a former "squadrista" and pet of Galeazzo CLANO, through whose influence GRILLO reached the upper echelons of the Foreign Ministry.
- 3. When it was learned in Rome that Mrs AUCE was to be efficiented Ambassador to Italy, a secret meeting was held in the home of Valerio June ORCHESE to devise ways and means of latching onto the new ambassador. At this meeting GRILLO and three other "gentiluomini" were chosen to "get in with" the ambassador. These individuals, is Rome's high society, are known as "sommozzatori" (frog-men or under-water demolitions men).
  - 4. Gidino has reportedly succeeded in gaining good entree to the Ambassador and takes advantage of this to monitor her official activities. One result of GRILLO's contact with the Ambassador has been, according to these same rumors, the change of tactics adopted by the Italian petroleum companies toward the Amoricano.
- 5. American petroleum intereste, allegedly being determined to absorb all Italian petroleum production, already have their representatives sounding out Italian petroleum personalities with a proposition involving American purchase of controlling stock in the Italian companies. | Gr. Uff. Rando Energy, prosident of API, Corso d'Italia, Rome, is one of the important Italiann who have received such a proposition. Printil discussed the matter with Comm. LO NACO, high-ranking functionary of the Italian Ministry of Industry. LO NONACO immediately informed MATTAI, and a conclave of Italian petroleum industry directors was called forthwith.

For reasons of secrecy the meeting took place in a locality in the suburbs of Rome early in July.

6. Ambassador LUCE's intense activity in favor of the seven big petroleum firms has slowed down since the fall officially, but several of her representatives have begun to maneuver with the CRI government. The attitude of Italian petroleum circles, informed as they are of the alleged American maneuvering, is hostile. They know that the Americans financially backed the Right in the recent Sicilian elections and fear that through wide use of the dollar, the Americans will succeed in demolishing all Italian resistance. Mistrust has reached such a point that a few days ago, when an American agent (of an oil company) asked for an appointment with MATTEL, the latter stated that he was out of town and immediately took off for the Amalfitana riviera.
