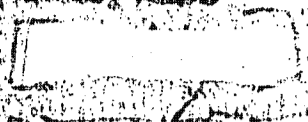

He stated that she plays football with the Mustangs and is a co-ordinator type, stated that she is a very good writer and is employed as a stringer for KAU and that he had used one or two of her articles after rewriting them.
