<p>1. MEXI 1875 of 10 December 1964 reported that Noe Palomares, <u>Oficial Mayor de Gobernacion</u>, had been released from his job by Luis ECHEVARRIA, the new Minister of Gobernacion. His replacement is Carlos GALVEZ Betancourt, formerly in the Legal Department of Gobernacion.</p> <p>2. Headquarters traces on GALVEZ follow:</p> <p>a) PBSWING Mexico City Dispatch 1603, 22 January 1953, reported that among the new appointments made by the Adolfo RUIZ CORTINES Administration in the Secretaria de Educacion Publica, was Lic. Carlos GALVEZ BETANCOURT, Assistant Director of Professions, who was described as having signed the Peace Congress Convocation in Mexico in 1949.</p> <p>b) [redacted] 426, 12 February 1958, reported that Carlos GALVEZ Betancourt, previously subchief of the Direccion de Profesiones, was named subchief of Immigration in February 1958. GALVEZ was described by LIKAYAK-2 as a strong pro-Communist.</p> <p>3. Since the KUBARK sensitive visa requests are handled now by GALVEZ, please forward Station traces and assessment of GALVEZ.</p>
