1. The following information was obtained from Pedro BOR

Pormar Coverno La 1

Representative of the Cuben Covernment accredited in Mexico. Orequete of the School of Espionage and Counter-Espionage in Havena in 1962.

- In the mouth of August or September 1961. In those days, VECA Perez was an instructor at the Officers Academy of the Castro regime and was also teaching an intensive course on espionage and counter-espionage to the future agents of the Castro regime in Latin America.
- b. VROA péres le white, was born circa 1919 in the City of Eavans, is about 5'10" tell, about 190 lbs., has dark brown hair, is single, and, according to source, is a homosexual. He is a close friend of Henuel PINEIRO Loseda, aka "Barba Boja."
- c. According to source, Poreign Service and Frence Latina personnel graduated free the School of Academy of Empionage. VEGA Pérez arrived in Mexico as Cultural Attaché of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico. Envever, at that time there were too many Cultural Attachés so VEGA Pérez was appointed as Cuban Press Attaché in Mexico. One of VEGA Pérez functions was to act as contact or linious between the foreign representatives of another country who arrived in Mexico and the Castro regime.
- d. In 1962, VICA Pdres engaged in the purchase of photographic equipment and films to be distributed together with the Communist propagands throughout Latin America. Between 1961 and 1962, VBCA Pdres was the Second Chief of the Center of all subversive, espionege and counter-espionage activities in Mexico.
- 2. The following information was obtained from the same source on Randa César Curro Montoto, who is mentioned in paragraph 5.c. of your sequent dated 23 Oct 64. Source reported the following information on Curro Montoto:

- a. Ramon César CUENCA Montote was introduced to source in Bavana by a man named (fnu) PONTEMAYOR who was an old mamber of the Spanish Communist Party. This MOFTEMAYOR was the Director of the Sepionage School in Hevena and was in charge of placing personnel in other countries.
- b. MOSTEMAYOR told source that he would receive orders in Mexico from CUENCA Montoto, who was the sole person Sutherised by the Castro regime to give the instructions. CUENCA was doing very sotive espionage and counter-espionage work in Mexico, and was the man in charge of taking care of every important personage who passed through Mexico.
- o. CUERCA Montoto was born circa 1936. is about 5'll tall. about 190 lbs.. has rather blond hair, is from Bavana, and wears glasses constantly.
- d. In 1962, CUEECA Montoto was acting as chief of the Consulates in Versorus, Tampico and Islas Mujeres, and, according to source, those were key Consulates for Communist subversion. CUENCA Montoto had close contact with a brother-in-law of Lásaro CARDEMAS, former Mexicas Freeldent, who was a peasant leader. Through that individual, he contacted various peasant leaders from different somes of the country, and CUEBCA Montoto made a trip through the interior of the country for that purpose.
- 2. The following information was furnished by Pedro MOIO Ortega) on Rogelio RODRINUEZ Lépes, who is sentioned in paragraph 5.a. of your sequest dated 33 Oct 64:
- E. Rogelia REDELIGUEZ López was acting in Marico as Second or Third Secretary of the Cuban Sabassy in Marico, and enjoyed the full confidence of the parsonnel attached to said Embassy. RODR MUEZ López was a very close friend of the code clerk of the Embassy, and used to stay in the norm where the code clerk deciphered the messages received.
- b. REDRIVEZ López Le wilte, bern circa 1935, about 5'10' tall, black hair, weeze glasses constantly due to sight defect, and was married in 1962 (cource does not remember the wife's asses). According to source, REDRIGUEZ Lópes had bourgeois testes and source doubts that REVERIUEE Lópes is a Communist.
