REGISTRATION - INTERNAL SECURITY MATTER

- 1. Enforced is cade to an inquiry to this Agency from your Euronu concerning Subjects, your Bureau's File No. 105-103036, and this Agency's tolotype No. 19754 dated 26 July 1968, Subject: "VLADIMIR SECEN INTERNAL SECURITY DOMINICAN REPUBLIC."
- 2. For your background information only, VLADIHIR SECEN was of operational interest to this Agency from 1963 to 1966 as an occasional source of information on Caribbean matters. SECEN's claim to your Bureau that he was involved in a plan to overthree the Government of Haiti and was being paid by this Agency in furtherance of this plan is completely false. Herever, SECEN did inform this Agency on two occasions that he was allegally involved in such a plan. A resume of these reports follows.

 3. On 9 February 1963, WACEN informed a representative from this Agency in Mismi that he had been offered a post as relitary advisor to an expedition being formed by Rolando MASFERNER Rojas, former Cuban Semiter, to depose President BUVALIER of Haiti. SECEN said he refused the post, but later said that MASFERNER had remarked publicly on several occasions that SECEN had accepted his proposition. According to SECEN, this was a tactic MASFERRER used to enhance the prestige of his movement.
- 4. On 2 Harch 1966, SECEN told a representative of this Agency in Niami that he had been contacted on 22 February 1966 by one Hile RAVLIC from Madrid who, according to SECEN, was en route to Haiti to perform a mission for President DUVALIER. According to SECEN, RAVLIC stopped in Minmi to see him. In their meeting, RAVLIC told SECEN that he had been contacted in mid-February in Madrid by a Dominican national residing in Haiti who was allegedly a confident

of President DUVALIER. The Dominican told RAVLIC that DUVALIER wanted to see him regarding VLADIMIR SECEM, an individual whom DUVALIER suspected of plotting to overthrow the Government of Haiti. DUVALIER wanted RAVLIC to influence SECEM to stop his Haitian plotting and, if SECEM agreed, DUVALIER was willing to offer SECEM a good job in the Haitian Government. SECEM reportedly told RAVLIC that he was not engaged in any plot to overthrow President DUVALIER and did not plan to become involved. RAVLIC then told SECEM that he was going to Haiti to report the results of his mission to President DUVALIER; however, when SECEM warned RAVLIC that such a trip would be too dangerous, RAVLIC took his advice and returned to Spain.

- 1111- 2972028 The files of this Agency reflect that Hile RAVLIC, also known as Mile RAVLIK de BOCETICH TEPCEVICE, Mille KRAWIT, and Major MILLER, was born 15 June 1919 in Croatia, Yugoslavia and is a naturalized citizen of the Dominican Republic. He studied agriculture in Zagreb, Yugoslavia, and graduated as an agronomist. During World War II, he was a mamber of the Croatian Army. In 1957, he joined the Dominican Army as a Major and became a Lt. Colonel under President TRUJILLO. In April 1967, a reliable source reported that RAVLIC, who traveled on a Dominican Republic pagaport, was apparently involved in an import-export business, but also carried out political and informationgothering missions. At that time RAVLIC was reported to have been in Madrid for the past month, but had made several trips to France. Squrce also said that RAVLIC continged to maintain contact with the TRUJILLOS. The nost recent information in this Agency's files reflects that in Soptomber 1967. RAVLIC was reportedly in Paris waiting for Mrs. Juan PERON. At that time, RAVLIC told a reliable source that he was in business with Juan PERCH.
 - 6. Although this Agency has no current operational interest in SECEN, we would appreciate receipt of any information which your Bureau may obtain on his activities in the Caribbean area, particularly in the Dominican Republic and Haiti or relating to the Cubana.
 - 7. The above information is being made available to your Bureau with the understanding that it will receive no further dissemination without prior approval from this office and will not be used in any interviews which your Eureau might have with SECEN.
