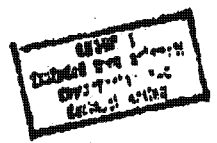

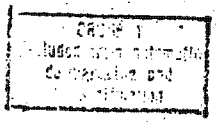

MEMORANDUM for the Record

Subject: [redacted]

15 June 63

On 14 June 63, LITANIL-3 and I went to Subject's home, where we held meeting. NO SECURITY PROBLEMS NOTED. Time: 1815-1900.

[redacted] reported as follows:

1. [redacted] reported that no "courtesy visas" on separate pieces of paper since the last report.

2. Miguel X REYES, Cuban Diplomat, went to Jamaica, where he will remain a short while and then return to Mexico, where he will remain approximately 5 days. REYES is an (Asesor Legal) ~~TECHNICAL~~ of the Ministerio de Industria. He is tall and wears glasses.

(COMMENT: A previous report indicated that Benigno CASTELLAR introduced REYES to [redacted])

3. [redacted] reported that the Cuban Embassy had 5000 copies printed of the Embassy Bulletin # 21 at the Imprenta Ladero - cost 7,108 pesos (Bulletin attached) *(copy forwarded to Wash)*

4. [redacted] provided the following address for Felipe X ROJAS Morales, Mexican Employee, at the Cuban Embassy:

Colonia Popular, Mexico, D.F.

5. Teresa PRONZA told [redacted] that her sister, "Cachita" PRONZA de X ROJAS is very anxious to go to Moscow. [redacted] said she thinks that she will be going to the Congreso de Mujeres.

6. [redacted] reported that she believes that the Embassy telephone has now been installed in Ramon SINOBAS apartment. It was previously reported that SINOBAS was transferring phone number 25-07-95 to his apartment. (COMMENT: It is recommended that LIFEAT be mounted soonest.)
