8. My relations with Mr. have been very good, and I am inclined to believe what he says. However, this whole matter, of course, would have to be evaluated by the Clandestine Services.

There is one other matter I would like to mention in connection with Mr. and that is that he served for two and a half months with a group of Cuban fliers in the Congo, as he holds a pilot's license.
