06 6. ⁰⁶ [redacted] reported that his wife advised Mrs. [redacted] that the SUBJECT was a friend of her husband, and that he, the SUBJECT, traveled a lot and merely used [redacted] place to leave some clothes and occasionally receive mail.

7. It is noted that in January 1961, items in the newspaper concerning CARSWELL's arrest by the Cubans listed his address at [redacted] in [redacted]

8. ⁰⁶ [redacted] was again requested to inform Agent O'HARE of any future contacts with him by anyone concerning the SUBJECT, and he again agreed to do so.
