

GZSUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

A call was received through the Agency Computer from Mr. Michael LaBorde regarding his missing father, Lawrence Joseph LaBorde. Mr. LaBorde explained that his father, Lawrence had previously worked for the Agency serving aboard the vessel TIBIN berthed in the Florida Keys which was used in operations against Cuba. Subject stated his father had left New Orleans six weeks ago aboard the Tugboat ALBATROSS enroute to Miami. The family has not heard from the senior LaBorde since and now are concerned for his safety. The subject's father was working for the Interstate Towing and Dredging Company, New Orleans, La. Mr. LaBorde was hopeful that the Agency could offer some information as to his father's whereabouts inasmuch as he felt that the Agency was still employing his father in cover capacity. The subject was directed to contact the employing firm, Interstate Towing and Dredging Company, to determine any information as where his father is located. He was most appreciative and stated he would make inquiries of the employing firm.

A review of COMINT records under the Subject name, LaBorde, failed to reflect any previous contact with Subject.
