- (1) (General) Among VOLSKY's Cuban contacts is Raul J. JBAS 1708, 201-240100, a member of the executive condittee of JURE; listed Hanolo RAY's right-hand man. This contact originated through the lose friendship of VOLSKY's wife with the diverced wife of CHIRAS and, a result, VCLSKY became closely connected with Hanolo's group. Acteding to JHWAVE traces, CHIRAS, the former director of the Havana litary Academy and reportedly an early ideal of Fidel CASTRO, defected 1850. He gave a three hour interview to Tad SZULC in Havana who ported him completely disillusioned with the Cuban Regime. However, IBAS had a definite record of Communist Party participation and was spected by ODENTY of being a CASTRO plant in the United States.

### (2) JURE Infiltration of KUBARK

- (a) When VOLSKY was first in contact with JMWAVE concerning details of his operation, March 1963, he made a particular point of antioning that he personally was convinced that none of the operations participants was presently controlled by any political group. - (3) JUNE Propaganda Program (VOLSKY, by virtue of his position the USIA is not allowed to belong to a political organization. However, he is a member of the executive board of JUNE and in charge of monting all JUNE propagance in the U.S. and in Latin America. This is held clandestinely by VOLSKY because of his USIA restrictions.)
- (a) AMTAUP-2 reported on 30 April 1933 that CISNEROS stated a JURE mosting that JURE planned to introduce into Cuba thousands of aflets whose sole purpose was to discredit the American Government. The leaflets were to include such matters as RAY's Manifesto against U.S. Government and KUBARK.
- (b) On 6 June 1963 RAY arrived in Miami from Puerto Rico d want directly to the home of CISNEROS where he called a meeting in ich he ordered that no further attacks be made on the U.S. Government he was to talk to Robert KENMEDY in Washington the next day. He then ried VOLSKY and reported these plans and asked him to submit a report him, the nature of which was unknown to source, AMTAUP-2. RAY also ked VOLSKY to give him information regarding the new propaganda plans
- (c) On 27 June 1963 RAY returned to Miami from Washington d went directly to JURE offices where he held a meeting saying he had ined more from his Washington contacts in the last month than he had the two previous years. He later called VOLSKY and held a conversation th him that lasted over a half hour.
- (d) On 18 July 1963 VOLSKY met with a JHVAVE case officer d stated that AMICE-27 had informed him that KUDARK felt that he OLSKY) was an informant for Manolo RAY. (1) On 27 January 1964 AMTAUP-2 reported that JURE had be laished the preparation of necessary plans to send youths to all Latin erican universities to lecture concerning KUBARK betrayal of U. S. olicy:

On 5 February 1964 a report was made on the Bay of Pigs Invasion by NBC television program which had been shown the night before. It was noted in this report that Antonio de la CARRERA Betancourt, one of the producers of the program, and come to Mismi in RUBARR. A-i stated that the lengthy intervention by CISNEROS was cabarrassing to the other Cubans but they refrained from interrupting in order to show solidarity in front of the visitors. A-1 stated that this presence of AMICE-27 and two USIA members led him to believe that WIM was responsible for the guest list and that therefore Jorge VOLSKY picked the "so called Cuban leaders that attended the meeting".

# d. VOLSKY's Relationship with the UR

(1) AMBLEAK-1, member of the UR and an old friend of VOLSKY ported the following brief resume of their acquaintence. On 19 November 1983 in a meeting with CO3, PEGINS, and AMICE-27, the purpose of which was to offer A-27 a position in the Station's MMAPRON Radio Program, A-27 said that he had written letters to VOLSKY and SZULC informing them that Coeration I commute had been terminated.
