SPECIAL OPERATIONAL

WHA REPORT (COMMUNIST ACTIVITIES)
(Also WHA REPORT, WHA 1000 (S))

1. Subject was born in Vienna, Austria, on 5 January 1920, to
Karel H.M., the brother of Willi and Alex (now deceased), the el-
dest of seven children, high school, and attended school in Vienna, and at
18, went to work for the Reichsbank in Vienna, where he met a Czech girl
Mary.

2. The couple worked in the following year with the company,
and on returning to Vienna, met Constant H.M., whom she married in 1940.
The couple went to Berlin where H.M. was editor of a Communist paper.
Subject played on the German stage for about 2 years. After three years
of married life (during which time she had become a Communist and had
been active in Communist Party work) she and H.M. separated.

3. Shortly thereafter, she fell in love with Dr. Julius H.M.,
an American citizen, who came to live in Vienna. A Communist, H.M. was
the co-editor of a book publishing company, "Kultur Verlag," a known
Party left-wing publishing firm, under the influence of the Communist
Party. In 1946 Subject divorced H.M. and married H.M. for whom
she had been working several years prior to their marriage.

4. Subject and H.M. went to Paris after their marriage and
then to the U.S., working at the U.S. Institute. After a brief stay in
New York, they went to San Francisco and lived with H.M. and his
wife in Berkeley, California. In January 1949 the couple returned to Vienna,
Austria, where H.M. worked for the Institute of Social Re-
search.
