BILL JOHNSON, AN AMERICAN PILOT WHO ARRANGES THE SUPPORT ASPECTS FOR SUCH STRIKES AGAINST CUBA, TOLD FIGRINI THAT HE AND MIKE RAFFERTY HAD HAD A HEATED ARGUMENT WITH ORLANDO BOSCH AVILA, MIRR LEADER, AT ABOUT 11:45 PM ON 15 FEBRUARY BECAUSE BOSCH WANTED HIS PILOT TO BOST THE CITY OF HABANA. JOHNSON AND RAFFERTY TRIED TO ADVISE BOSCH
