Burckhardt is his "right arm"; he confers with "Frits"; Ostins, of the Vichy Legation, whose guest he was at the farewall dinner for d'Amade, is under his orders and sees him daily. Subject is married and spends his week-ends at Villa Bella, Estoril (Tel: 608), a house known to be rented to a German couple and used as a meeting-place.

He thought Wattel was an emissary from Algiers and trusted him because Mms. de Horonha had vouched for him. Wattel and Chatel both urged him to contact Monnier, and Wattel persuaded him to attend Ostin's farewell dinner for d'Amade, of the Vichy Legation.

#### LEBRUM

Mattel advises egainst contacting him; states that subject may be leaning toward the British or he may be acting under orders from Chatel or Gorrier. His position is not at all clear.

In June was interested with Wattel in getting some merchandise into Spain.

LIMAS (Bro) (Enllis de Gracia Mais o Limas) cer Portigal

Wattel's good friend, for some time, at least. Wattel says: "I don't think that Mrs. Limes is a very bright person, but she is well-bred, has good culture, and a very strong will." He canims to have trained her, he have "moral power" over her, and maintains she is a person devoted to the Allied cause who has, indirectly, furnished information to the British. At Wattel's urging, she met Horonne and was enwared by him as a German arent, Wattel insisting, however, that she reveal to him the work she did for the Hasis. Horonne planned to send her to Brasil, where she has an uncles while waiting for the visa she was to watch the British and Americans in Lisbom. Subject speaks French fluently and was recommended by Wattel to Gowlier, of Free French Forces, for Africa. Her mother fights with Wattel.

#### LORENCO. Ca:x4.

Is reported to have had two P.V.D.E. Inspectors at Oporto, Games and Haron, arrested for differing with him and Capt. Oliveirs on political patters.

LOUREIRO Cot Portugal

Head of the organisation that forged Contaguage masseries. Subject, a one-time police informer, is reported to be a communist; his organisation is believed to have been financed by the French communist party and to have been working for the Allied cause. He was a dislocatic courier, traveling to France every month, where he sold the paraports to various Legations for the purpose of getting men in and out of the country. In this he was sometimes aided by his friend, the Portuguese Consul at Marseilles. He once offered Wattel 50 passports for 40,000 escudos. When arrested, in April, he refused to name the French officials involved, or the printers and engravers in Lisbon who had forged the documents. He admitted his contacts

with the Belgians, however. The organisation was betrayed by <u>Victor Costman</u>
Subject is unverticed as confiding and talketive, but an unpleasant man. He was released from prison on June 18.

She claims she has only known him a short time; first heard of him through her physician, Br. Gammova Alves.

MANRILE INCL CIT USA

An American connected with the American Intelligence Service. He attracted the attention of the Germans by shipping radio transmitters to heatrie in the Swiss pouch. Wattel was ordered by the "Big Chief" to watch

Thus, on May 5, there was a meeting in Horonha's office between subject, Moronha, a Portuguese business man and an Criental, probably a Japanese, who spoke Portuguese very well. On June 6, while Boronha

was in Madrid, subject is known to have phoned that city and told the person on the wire to stop everything and hold the documents, he would be going to Bercelone that night. Subject had many conversations with Horonia upon the latter's return from Madrid.

#### HOMETER

In May, Mettal reported that subject was planning to get in touch with Algiers where his presence would be welcome. Subject left for Vichy stortly afterward.

#### MOGUES. General

Tattel ses ordered in June to contact subject at Batalha; Governor Chatel would have introduced him. Germans believed, at the time, that they could get subject to return to Vichy.

Subject is allied to the Sounith royal family; she is an intimate friend of Salasar's and is very influential. She is also believed to be the mistress of Marshal Mannigim of Finland, and in June asked Wattel to make a report for the Marshal on the political situation in Europe and Morth Africs. Wattel, in May, says that Chatel promised to introduce him to subject, yet elsewhere he states that he had set her before, through Alexis layer of the French Foreign office. She had remembered him and had vouched for him to Latour. Subject told Wattel, in June, that she new Osmin's secretary at a private showing of movies at the British Francey.

Subject is a notive of India. He is slim; his face is long and thin, the eyes a light blue and the complexion regular. When smoking to stee a long, thin aluminum digarette-holder. He weeks his not down over his fore-head and a little to the left.

Both Wattel and British agree that subject recruite agents for the German Intelligence Service. He first interviewed Wattel in rison in October, 1942; charged him a fee of 20,000 escudos for his release, then got him to join the German organisation, under pressure, Wattel maintains. Later, in March, he similarly recruited Wattel's friend, Mrs. Linas. Shortly afterward, he appeared greatly worried by the actions of the police who suddenly began arresting Gestapo agents.

Subject was reported at a very early date to be interested in the commercial activities of the Germans and to be buying various products for them. In February he was commissioned by the German Embassy to buy 400 tons of coffee. When it was ready to be shipped, subject ciained to have sufficient influence with Lisbon harbor authorities to arrange for the ship's departure without a "navicert" and, in April, when it was finally decided to send this soffee overland to Spain, he suggested the "landcort" by applied for in Oporto where the Allies were less observant. Once, in Wattel's presence, he received an urgent call from a Mr. Bedon (Redon?) and hurried over to No. 34, Avenida 24 de Julho, the head office of the Portuguese Air Mavigation Go. where, later, he told of meeting members of important Gormon firms (one driving a CD car No. HELO20) and discussing with them a matter involving sommercial documents that was to bring him 100,000 escudos. Then, in April, he was reported to be trying to ship 200 tens of whole oil to Spain. Brumo Mayer was a frequent visitor and it is possible that subjects trip to Madrid im June was on some business errand for this man. Subject often acts as intermedicry for Mayer in his contacts with Portuguese firms. May 6, for example, in subject's office were present: Mayer, a Portuguese business man, and an Oriental, possibly a Japanese, who spoke Portuguese very wall. In June subject negotiated the purchase, by the Germans, of a product called Benacao" (probably canned casao), the selier being L.J. Rosenbusch Helimutt and the intermediary Philip Syxteer. The merchandise was to be delivered at Vise, in transit for Switserland. Subject, Wettel adds, planned to remove a cargo of cacao from a Portuguese ship in the Trgus, substitute a false cargo, insure it with a German firm, then have the ship souttled while en route to Bibao.

Subject appears to have been in prison in February, but whether this was as a prisoner himself, or as legal aid to prisoners, the reports do not

make clear. In prison he heard a certain Jose Estesta tell of a pro-Ailied group that planned sebotage in the event of a German invasion. Wattel reports that subject revealed this information to the police, which resulted in the arrest of Jose Batesta, Condes, and others. He is reported to have also met in prison a certain Eugenic Ascue, a Cuban under detention for dealing in centraband, and to have given him some dollar checks. Subject is a friend of Capt. Jose Cerreia d'Aimeida of the Police and is often seem in him company. Was involved in the Captain's errest of Loureiro in the "Portuguese Passport" case. Subject wanted Wattel to contact David Costodio, a young American expecting to return to the United States and once asked him to approach a certain young man of 20 who sold lace in the streets.

In March, subject was visited by a group of Frenchaen, one of whom is believed to be a member of the Legation; and another Frenchaen was seen at his effice on April; 19. Subject calls several times a week at the Brazilian Embassy. He is frequently observed at the Care Cristal, usually with two or three others, but sometimes with an Italian. He is often in the company of a man who lives at No. 32, Travessa do Cabral, or nested with yet another, at the Cafe Micola.

Wattel had subject followed on his trip to Madrid, to try to pin on him the charge of smuggling money, but was unsuccessful. In another report that is not at all clear, Wattel claims that subject was connected with something, or someone, called "American Joint" for he noticed a statement of 17,000 escudos.

Waitel, in his description of subject's office, points out that the elients and the informants use the same waiting room, therefore could be secretly photographed. Six o'clock would be the best hour. Subject shares the office with several solleagues, one of whom, a dermanophobe, has the room next to subject's, and could be bribed to let one enter and listen to senversations through the thin partition.

PLIVEIRA (Cape) Gasour d' Cut : Portugal

In June he left his hotel because certain documents had disappeared from his room, and he moved into a private fint (Tel: 52887). Wattel edds that these documents revealed nothing. Subject is under Dr. Ereel's orders and has almost daily contacts with him. Although an agent of the secret political section, to which he was appointed by Vichy, subject's activities are restricted to the commercial field. Mac. de Noronha reported to Wattel in June that he had seen his secretary at a private showing of movies at the Ditish Enbassy.
