1. Attached are photographic copies of the following documents:

- a) An agreement dated 29 November 1953 in which Eduardo Sabatino agreed to sell certain arms and aircraft valued at \$850,000. U.S. currency to ^(copy) Major Jose Eduardo Montenegro Paniagua, an exiled Guatemalan army officer. Note: As of May 1954, Montenegro was in a Mexico City jail for failure to pay his hotel bill.
- b) A letter, or note, dated 30 June 1954 from Eduardo Sabatino B. to Robert ^(copy) Alvarado Fuentes, for Guatemalan Ambassador to Mexico. There is no indication that this letter was mailed.
- c) A letter dated 22 March 1950 from the Chief of Police, Miami Shores Village, Florida, stating that Edward Browder, Jr., a resident of Miami Shores Village, is a law abiding citizen of that town.
- d) A letter dated 3 August 1954 from Edward Browder B. to ^(copy) Col. Marcos Pares Jimenez, President of Venezuela. There is no indication this letter was mailed.
- e) A letter dated 3 August 1954 from Edward Browder to ^(copy) (General) Fulgencio Batista, of Cuba. There is no indication this letter was mailed.
- f) An undated letter (probably July 1954) from Eduardo Sabatino B. to an unnamed Ambassador, possibly the Nicaraguan Ambassador to Mexico.
- g) A letter dated 1 August 1954 from Edward Browder Sabatino to General A. Bonilla, of Nicaragua.
- h) This document appears to be a part of an agreement whereby subject will operate in Europe in behalf of an un-named government.

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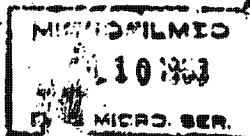

- i) This document appears to contain call letters for radio stations and cryptic symbols for certain countries.
 - j) This document contains rough drawings of bombs and grenades.
 - k) A letter signed Eduardo and dated 30 July (1954) at Guatemala City. It appears from this letter that subject may have gone to Guatemala City after his escape on 16 June 1954 from the custody of Mexican Immigration authorities.

2. Edward Browder, Jr. has a long record for violations of the Neutrality Act and other federal statutes in the United States. His whereabouts since his escape from the custody of Mexican Immigration officials on 16 June 1954, is unknown.

El Mayor Montenegro compromete a pagar la mitad de el precio de las armas al dia siguiente de la venida de Honduras de el Licenciado apoderado Sr. Carlos Aurelio Recinos, quien tiene en su poder la cantidad de dinero suficiente a pagar para todo de los cuantos de este movimiento. El otro mitad de este suma a ser pagado en el puerto de Cortes, Republica Honduras al desembarcar toado el armamento.
- 2: El Señor Eduardo Sabatino se compromete seriamente a entregarle al Mayor Montenegro este lote de armas incluyendo los aviones mencionado y a toda del otra que consiste en una lista en posesion del Mayor. Tambien El Señor Sabatino compromete a ayudare el Mayor Montenegro en todo lo necesario para subir al poder y haber derrocado al actual Gobierno Comunista de Guatemala, hasta llevar a feliz termino lo deseado.
- 3: El Señor Sabatino tambien se compromete a entregarle al Mayor Montenegro diez pilotos Americanos, expertos en la zona mencionado y dos Jefes de infanteria, y a ser dirigida de los Americanos en sus trabajos.

IF DURING THIS VERY TEMPORARY LEASE FIRE Agreement, you desire to arrange purchase of several military aircraft of the type and size suitable for present operations in your country, I will be glad to discuss terms with you personally.

IMMEDIATE FLIGHT DELIVERY CAN BE ARRANGED DIRECTLY TO ANY AIRPORT EXCEPT LA HABANA, AND HIGHLY COMPETENT FLIGHT PERSONNEL ARE AVAILABLE TO REMAIN WITH THE AIRCRAFT AND TO ENGAGE IN MILITARY OPERATIONS.

NEGOTIATING AND ARRANGEMENTS OR DISCUSSIONS WILL HAVE TO BE ON A VERY PERSONAL AND DISCREET BASIS - AS MY ACTIVITIES ARE UNDER HEAVY SURVEILLANCE BY BOTH THE U.S. DEPT. OF STATE AND MEXICAN AUTHORITIES AND I DO NOT WISH ANY ADDITIONAL TROUBLE FROM EITHER GROUP.

THE AIRCRAFT AND SOME OTHER MATERIAL BEING USED BY COLONEL CASTRO ARMY AND HIS MEN, WERE SUPPLIED BY ME, AND MY ACTIVITIES IN THE ARMS BUSINESS ARE WELL KNOWN, THEREFORE YOU NEED HAVE NO DOUBTS AS TO MY ABILITY TO DELIVER WHATEVER IS ORDERED.

PERHAPS YOU MAY THINK IT IS TOO LATE NOW THAT THIS IS A TEMPORARY TRUCE, BUT I CAN ASSURE YOU THAT COLONEL CASTRO ARMY AND HIS MEN ARE EFFICIENTLY AS WE WILL ACCEPT NO COMPROMISING ARRANGEMENTS.

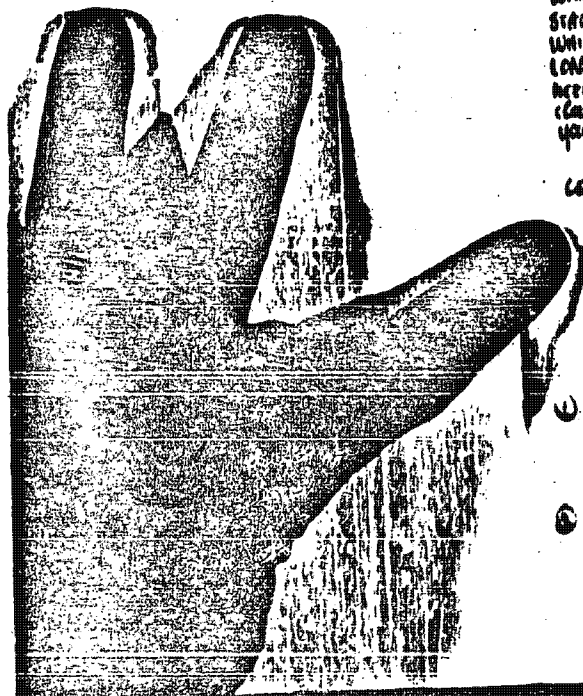

TO THE AMBASSADOR:

The present government of Jose Figueres in Costa Rica is a puppet government of the United States. It is an invasion somewhat similar to the one made by the Central Intelligence Agency in Guatemala. It is a large scale operation with a high degree of secrecy and preparation. It is a matter of preparation and planning.

If your Government would be interested in having a more complete and unofficial representation of the Junta than the present Costa Rica, it can be arranged. It is a matter of financial assistance which is required for the purchase of essential equipment.

This offer is made from mercenary motives only. It is not because I desire to see your country become a puppet. I have a considerable amount of time, money and arms invested in this project, and am in a position to control the leading elements of the revolutionary group. I can maintain that control after the seizure of the government.

If you desire to discuss this with me personally and in full detail, I am available at your convenience. I am in the provisions outlined herein. Due to current legislation with revolutionary groups in this territory, and a reputation for arms smuggling, the Department of State in my country (USA) and members of several other governments, have taken serious interest in my activities and my whereabouts. Therefore it is necessary for me to use discretion in my movements and I do not wish to come to your Embassy during my absence, since the local FBI agents are presently looking for me in Mexico.

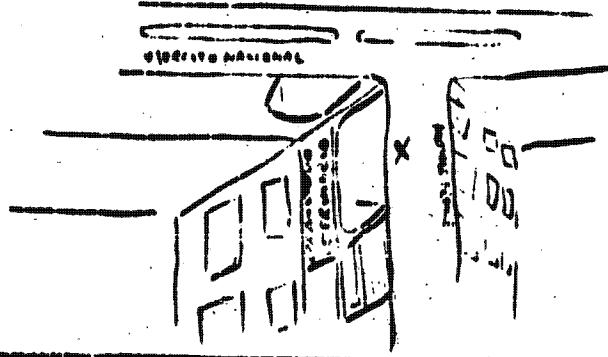

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I regret my inability to contribute my plans and ideas in detail, especially after your prompt action was your assistance in Mexico to solve my travel problems. However, to you have no doubt, from information, I have been detained by means of investigation in Mexico City on some presumptions regarding investigation of a military but might be very well communicated the whole truth with in one or more private talks. Escobar seems their noticeable attention but I wanted to leave the country without delay. I have, needless to say, worn out my welcome in Mexico City and am anxious to get away from there. All this is due to my inability to arrive in Managua - I was so engaged on the way to airport to make the flight to Managua.

The matters which I desire to discuss separately with you involve several items among the most important of which may well be the movement against you financed by figures and headed by Julio Soto, who was on the verge of arriving, purchase of food for the military, to use in a possible attack on your residence. These plans were delayed with a quantity of arms and ammunition were seized in Mexico City, efforts of Dr. Acosta and other contacts. (See below, all of which you know) and Julio left town abruptly. I have lost some of my informants due to my rapid departure from Mexico - but have none yet in Mexico, apart from one in Montreal. You know of course that Julio claims to be acting as contact of Dr. Soto - but I have definite proof of his monthly coming from Julio Soto, who will probably be waiting for him when he returns. I have a contact who will inform me if he actually contacted for.

One other matter involves Roberto de la Cruz - who has fallen, like what he thought was neutral and uncontaminated source two aircraft (A-20 Douglas Aircraft Company) and 100 men were to go American pilots in a surprise raid on your residence that is the intention. Volunteered to me by one of the pilots (Nikolai) from the staff of de la Cruz. I think this plan was foiled out also - mainly due to inability to find pilots willing to accept. The Guatemala incident seemed to throw everything plans and time tables out of gear. I had a date in Tegucigalpa with some of the people left behind in Guatemala and managed to make it (I had to get out of the country) with that situation settled, and my finances improved - I intended to do everything possible to assist in the existing of liquidity. I am aware of the general plan of most everything involved, including Dr. Calderon's plan - and I believe that there are several things which are involved well - in a financial matter - and I am sure that the big plans are involved, complicated and costly. I don't know how far the generals are on basis of what most of the other movements seem to count on - which is the primary mission in Guatemala. However, I do know and count as a friend, one of the Spanish (Albino) - Colonel Julio Lopez A. Viqueza - and I am disposed to help him immediately - to launch a force of well-trained personnel in Costa Rica to launch an

- 25 cases 60% dynamite + 1000 lbs of minute fuse - 500 # of caps. I have 50 more (MAGNETO TYPE)

It may be necessary to utilize either Puerto Cabezas or Bluefield as a base to store
the two medium bombers. I am sure there are no suitable fields in eastern Costa Rica - The PBY
is amphibious and will use the ocean front to land supplies etc. The Colonel (Lopez)
would be pleased if he could be lifted (located P.V.) in the local area. I remain in Puerto Cabezas
from the Department of Movement. I put my P-10's and C-46 in there. If you still have on
hand, the various items, I am that abortive attempt. I can utilize the explosives - dynamite

'cargo' for the two P.V.'s after their arrival. The PBY is available immediately upon
receipt of your okay. And the other aircraft can be sent after I have put the Colonel

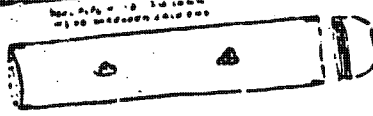

2. Airline Pilot License - PERMANENT VALIDATION - SHOW NAME AS PASSPORT
3. RADIO OPERATORS LICENSE - 1st CLASS INTERNATIONAL - " " " "
4. COMMISSION AS COLONEL - *flora Foley - stationed as Air Attache - or Intelligence Attache*
with permanent security documents - no clearance - with assignment to Europe (ITALY - FRANCE)
on a test and evaluation mission, as personal delegate of Ambassador to Africa.
Permanent studies of suitable combat aircraft, which presumably will be furnished by a 1948 date
for the Republic of the Congo.
5. Expense account of \$500⁰⁰ US. for income, to cover operations in Europe.
6. Letter of credit for unlimited amount on any Swiss bank suitable - payable in US. Dollars
pending Order of "Warranted" bank opening. This operation to give a minimum of
the United States dollar for year, to be divided 50/50 between Ambassador and pilot.
7. A Douglas C-47 or C-54 to be furnished please see other letters.

The pilot to be immune from arrest, seizure or detention of any sort when his aircraft
is in the country, in furtherance of which, the pilot to cooperate and advise you personally
to those concerning the interests and for further information by Ambassador Ambassador of
the country.

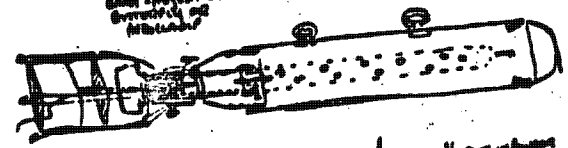
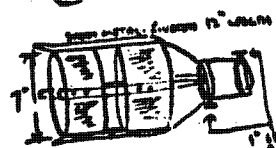
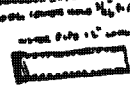
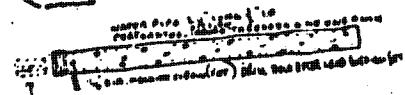
