le This memorandum is written at the request of Mr.T.Karamessines in connection with a preliminary dissemination, (OUT 92570), dated 22 November 1954.

2. Information was received in early October 1954 that one McComMack (FMU), an American in Honduras had written Senora Rosario FUERTALIANO and requested one and one-half million dollars for investment in the sugar industry in Honduras. Senora Rosario FUERTALIANO is a Filipina who reportedly heads a Fhilippine syndicate interested in investing large amounts of United States currency.

3. Upon querying the Station the following information received on one John McCORMACK 877 (IN 152397 16 October 1954):

The only record of an American citizen named McCORMACK in the citizenship files of the State Department installation in Tegucigalpa was an application for registration of one John McCORMACK, dated 6 January 1953, containing the following data: Born 16 March 1902, at Millseat, Texas; Legal residence, 2140 East Mohave Street, Phoenix, Arizona; Occupation, civil engineer, Jones (Anstruction Company, John McCORMACK resided in Pansma 1942-1944; Equador, 1945-1947 and 1946-1951; Guatemal 2 1947-1948; and Saudi Arabia 1951-1952. John McCORMACK was retrieved from employment with the Jones Construction Company and reportedly returned to the United States in March 1954, according to information given to a Department of State employee by an employee of the Jones Construction Company.
