- 1. Reference is made to the telephone request received 8 September 1965 from Mr. Stoner concerning Subject. The files of this office contain the following information which was previously forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 2. Information dated August 1959 from a fairly reliable source indicated that the home of Subject [Dominick Edward BARTONE aka BARTONI aka BERTONE aka BERTONI aka Mick BARTON, born 3 August 1913 in New York City] at 4236 Chase Avenue, Mismi Beach, Florida, was the site of a meeting 10 August 1959 of Major William Alexander MORGAN and a group of Cubans opposed to Fidel CASTRO's regime. During the meeting, MORGAN received \$140,000 in cash from two of the Cubans present, for use against CASTRO. (An untested source reported in March 1959 that Subject had befriended MORGAN when Subject was trying to sell Globe-master aircraft to the Cuban Revolutionary Air Force.)
- 3. According to reporte dated 25 August and 25 August 1959 from a fairly reliable and sensitive source. Subject sent Miami lawyer Andrew PSALIDAS to Panama with \$70,000 in each to open a checking account in the Panama City branch of the National City Bank in the name of Servicios Internacionales. SA. The sole authorized signature on checks was to be that of Subject, and the local legal representative was the firm ARIAS, FABRECIA and FABRECIA. Source believed that the funds were connected with MORCIAN.
- 265 54 8 1694 Cm 4 September 1959 the same source indicated that \$60,000 had been withdrawn from the account by PEALIDAS....
