- 1. Foresyded under separate cover are sample press elippings relative to subject's visit to Montevideo.
- 2. As noted in referenced cobles, subject's visit rade a great impact upon Urogueyan public opinion, largely as a result of excellent media support, a large propertion of which was entirely sponteneous. While he did receive various essists from station essets, his own superb memor and the content of his message were what produced the fine localmedia reaction and what made the best impact on the Drugueyan public. - 4. COME's greatest schievement took place on the night of 17 March in the Plane Independencia when he endressed a husbed suffence of 5000. This was a far cry from the roudy Communist claque of the previous night and the impressive turnout gave emple proof of the true sentiments of the Unique year public at large. Press comment the following day will be noted in the separate cover attachment.
- 5. Station EUCAGE principal agent, ATAME, reported that COMME was well pleased with the results of his visit to Hostevideo and grateful for the many opportunities he had to express himself on the subject of Fidel Costro and the distortion of the Cuben revolution.
