ACTIVITIES REQUIRED - REFERENCES

1. Subject told the Deputy Chief PESWING in late December that he planned to leave Haiti for PEPRIME towards the end of February or early March 1966. Subject said that his original contract with the GCH had fallen through, that he had not received anyaisal in return for his services to the GCH in the last year and that the GCH in fact owed him \$100,000. Subject said that he planned to spend six weeks or so in PEPRIME and then returned to Haiti without his wife to try to arrange to receive his back pay in the form of real estate, preferably property on the coast with tourist/commercial potential.
2. Though <sup>02</sup>EVKINOR-1's reporting has stopped, there has been no evident change in Subject's behavior in Haiti. His close contact remains Wlodzislaw GALICKI (201-319948), the Polish Commercial Representative in Haiti. One Haitian merchant accused GALICKI of using Subject to widen his contacts in the GCH. Subject has also been on close terms with Nicolas I. Roude (201-230416), suspected Soviet Agent. Subject and his wife are gregarious and have made many contacts in Haiti.
