MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, WH/4/CI
SUBJECT : CALYPSO - AMDEP/1 Radio Ship

At your request I telephoned J. Walter Yeagley, Assistant Attorney General, on 12 April 1961. I explained to Mr. Yeagley that we were most concerned with the activities of AMDEP/1's ship, the CALYPSO, and were most desirous that it be neutralized by whatever legal means possible. Mr. Yeagley stated that he could not, at this point, give a firm answer as to what legal means could be brought to bear to hold the boat in some sort of protective custody. He did promise, however, to investigate the matter and advise us accordingly.
