1. EARLY MORNING 10 FEB AMDIP-1 CALLED BENDER SAYING HE WOULD STOP RECRUITMENT RECRUITS TO CAMPS WHICH ACCORDING AMDIP SCHEDULED TODAY. AMDIP-1 STATED THAT AS MATTER OF PRINCIPLE NO CUBAN CAN AGREE SUPERIORITY OF MILITARY OVER CIVILIAN AUTHORITY. ALSO PROBLEM CREATED BY UNILATERAL U.S.A. ACTION IN CONNECTION AMROEC-1 DISMISSAL MUST BE SOLVED. AMDIP-1 PROPOSES QUIT HIS TRIP TO CAMPS WOULD BE BEST SOLUTION.
2. BENDER TOLD AMDIP THAT ANY INTERFERENCE WITH RECRUITMENT OR SHIP-MENT TROOPS COMPLETELY UNACCEPTABLE. IN FACT BENDER NOT PREPARED CONTINUE NEGOTIATE HIM WITH AMDIP UNDER THIS TYPE PRESSURE. BENDER SUGGESTED PATIENCE UNTIL RETURN HAMILTON WHO CURRENTLY GETTING FIRST HAND BRIEFING THIS SITUATION.
3. IN VIEW VERY HARD BENDER LOSE AMDIP ENDED CONVERSATION WITH PROMISE NO INTERFERENCE IN RECRUITMENT AND TO AWAIT QUIETLY HAMILTON'S RETURN TO U.S.A. NEXT WEDNESDAY.
