1. On 5 November 1963, Henry P. RYERHOLTZ received a telephone call from Subject, who said that he was leaving on 7 November for Puerto Rico where he and an unnamed friend would go into the architectural and drafting business. He gave his forwarding address as: Las Palmas 1413 Apartment 1, Santurce, Puerto Rico.

2. Subject apologized for having been so much trouble, and assured the case officer that his many mistakes in the JMWAVE area were the result of an excess of patriotic zeal. He added a note of appreciation for the case officer's patience with him, and said that he would always be willing to serve the PERUMEN cause if KUBARK required.

3. For your information, Subject was for a time a major figure in ANSCROLL, which is notionally subsidized by a group of Latin Americans including SEKWER-1. He may take it into his head therefore, to contact SEKWER-1 with a request for financial support for operational undertakings (Subject thinks that SEKWER-1 actually contributes to ANSCROLL). It would be wise to warn SEKWER-1 of this possibility. 02

4. Subject has had dealings with four JMWAVE case officers who were uniformly unsuccessful in attempts to make him a productive FI, PV or PM agent. Subject is definitely not recommended to San Juan Station, although JMWAVE has no reason to disqualify him with a "burn" notice.

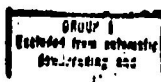
