SOURCE: A former Marxist intellectual who continues to maintain close association within radical and leftist circles. Source's reporting has been generally reliable in the past. He obtained this information from Ahmed Gora Ebrahim, an official of the Pan Africanist Congress (PAC), who talked with Subject in Cairo in early November 1967.

These two jobs keep him extremely busy; however, he expressed some doubt about the longevity of his Radio Cairo job.
