<p>1. As requested in reference, Donald E. WIDERTYRE discussed Subject with Wilbur Wright. Though Mr. Wright has not seen Subject for several months, he is certain that he is still in town. Mr. Wright informed WIDERTYRE that Subject holds a BA from Colombia, served during World War II in the Philippines as a First Lieutenant in an engineering company which was all colored, and he was bitter over this segregation practice. He comes from New York, and Wright believes he lived in Harlem. He did join the Communist Party between 1951 and 1954 but has since left it. His reason for leaving the Party is not known. He went to China in 1960, and while there grew to hate it because of the lack of academic freedom and the restrictions on his movement. He came to Cairo from China. Currently he very much likes American sodas such as Scotch which he drinks with restraint, and cigarettes, etc. Since he has been in Cairo he has worked for MENA, the Arab Observer magazine and since 1964 the advertising firm of Hamilton Wright. He is talking about getting married to an unidentified Egyptian. He has been married but is divorced. His Arabic is good and Wright describes him as bright. He has the capacity to lie easily and without compunction. He is currently not manifesting much interest in politics. He goes to Maxim's Restaurant, a local discotheque, frequently.</p> <p>2. We have no additional current information about Subject other than that reported in [NECA] 13627, 27 March 1965.</p>
