Joint author of a report on revolutionary meeting held by Fidel CASTRO in Miami at the Flagler Theater in Miami on 20 Nov. 1955. The report was published in Bohemia. Subj. a vehement opponent of Batista, is the secretary general of the "unified" Organizaciones de Raul CASTRO. Allegedly, he is foremost among supporters of Fidel CASTRO within that Organizaciones group. At the aforementioned meeting in Miami, CONTE spoke at the gathering.

Reported to be a bodyguard accompanying CASTRO to the U.S. In 1949 the Communist Party of Cuba proposed establishing a new organization called National Congress for Peace and Democracy. A petition endorsing the organization was signed by a list of individuals described as Communist sympathizers, including Luis CONTE Aguero.
