3. Bookine interrogated Sandvik again on 2 May, at which time the latter gave him the two reports that he had been asked to prepare (Attchment B and C). Since nothing turned up that had not been reported earlier or that was not included in the reports Sandvik had prepared, no separate account of this interview was made.

4. Sandvik is no longer with the Embassy. Because of his poor job performance (he was on probation at the time), of his匠migrant background, and the danger as a security risk Sandvik was asked to resign his position at the Embassy on 5 May. He left on the morning of that date & but we understand that his resignation is not effective until 19 May 1961.
