1. Forwarded under separate cover is a copy of DIR 16720 prepared by LUWCLP following the Central American Student Conference held in San Jose, Costa Rica, in June 1962. It was an oversight that WAES was not included as an addressee on this cable originally.
2. The cable is sent to you in order to give you a review of events at the conference, which included ANFPMLL representatives. As the conference turned out, the central issue was a resolution on Cuba which divided the delegations 3 to 3 with one—the Guatemalan—undecided. Under considerable pressure the Guatemalan delegation eventually capitulated, resulting in the conference breaking up without a resolution critical of Cuba.
3. Your attention is called to paragraph 47, mentioning the ANFPMLL delegates. These are the remnants of the LUWCLP agent, KNGSOH2.
